

HHO flight	a flight by a helicopter operating under an HHO approval, the purpose which is to facilitate the transfer of persons and/or cargo by means of a helicopt hoist		
HEMS flight	a flight by a helicopter operating under a HEMS approval, the purpose of which is to facilitate emergency medical assistance, where immediate and rapid transportation is essential, by carrying: (a) medical personnel; (b) medical supplies (equipment, blood, organs, drugs); or (c) ill or injured persons and other persons directly involved		
low-visibility operations (LVOs)	sapproach or take-off operations on a runway with a runway visual range less than 550 m or with a decision height less than 200 ft

1. Introduction

1.1 Background

Guidance Material (GM) for Specific Approvals for Operators is issued by the Executive Director of the

Albanian Civil Aviation Authority (ACAA) from time to time to provide practical guidance or certainty in respect

of the statutory requirements for aviation safety. GM contains information about standards, practices and

procedures acceptable to ACAA.

1.2 Purpose

The purpose of this publication is to inform all Albanian Air Operator Certificate (AOC) holders about their

responsibilities in this domain, addressing the general requirements and procedures to be followed by them

in order to apply to and to maintain specific approval granted by ACAA.

1.3 Applicability

All aircraft operators conducting operations under Albanian Legislation shall meet the requirements set forth

in this GM.

2. General Requirements

2.1 Competent Authority

The competent authority for issuing a specific approval for a commercial air transport operator with its main

place of business being in Albania is the ACAA.

2.2 Application for a specific approval

The operator applying for the initial issue of a specific approval shall provide to the competent authority the documentation required in the applicable area, together with the following information:

- The name, address and mailing address of the applicant;
- A description of the intended operation;
- The operator shall provide to the competent authority compliance with the requirements of the applicable area;
- The operator shall retain records relating to the items referred above at least for the duration of the operation requiring a specific approval;
- Operating procedures should be documented in the operations manual. If an operations manual is
 not required, operating procedures may be described in a manual specifying procedures (procedures
 manual). If the aircraft flight manual (AFM) or the pilot operating handbook (POH) contains such
 procedures, they should be considered as acceptable means to document the procedures.

2.3 Privileges of an operator holding a specific approval

The scope of the activity that an operator holding an AOC is approved to conduct shall be documented and specified in the operations specifications to the AOC.

2.4 Changes to a specific approval

When the conditions of a specific approval are affected by changes, the operator shall provide the relevant documentation to the competent authority and obtain prior approval for the operation.

2.5 Continued validity of a specific approval

Specific approvals shall be issued for an unlimited duration and shall remain valid subject to the operator remaining in compliance with the requirements associated with the specific approval and taking into account the relevant elements defined in the data established in accordance with Minister Order 80, subpart Spa.

3. Specific Approvals Required by ACAA

3.1 List of Mandatory Specific Approvals

- Performance Based Navigation (PBN) Operations
- Operations with Specified Minimum Navigation Performance Specifications (MNPS)
- Operations in Airspace with Reduced Vertical Separation Minima (RVSM)
- Low Visibility Operations (LVO)
- Extended Range Operations with Two-Engine Aeroplanes (ETOPS)
- Transport of Dangerous Goods (DG)
- Helicopter Operations with Night Vision Imaging Systems (NVIS)
- Helicopter Hoist Operations (HHO)
- Helicopter Emergency Medical Service (HEMS) Operations
- Electronic Flight Bag (EFB)

3.2 Individual Approval Specific Requirements

The goal of this GM is not to individually address the specific requirements necessary for an operator to get a specific approval on PBN, MNPS, RVSM, LVO, ETOPS, DG, NVIS, HHO, HEMS or EFB. In fact, only general requirements and procedures deemed mandatory by ACAA are addressed in this document.

Therefore, all applicable national and international legislation should be consulted in order to verify specific requirements and procedures are necessary for a commercial air transport operator to apply for each of these ten different areas.

- Upon receiving an application for the issue of a specific approval or changes thereof, ACAA shall
 assess the application in accordance with the relevant requirements Part-SPA and conduct, where
 relevant, an appropriate inspection of the operator.
- 2. When satisfied that the operator has demonstrated compliance with the applicable requirements, the competent authority shall issue or amend the approval. The approval shall be specified in the operations specifications, for commercial air transport operations.
