1. INTRODUCTION

This guidance material provides detailed information on the approval / acceptance process for CAMO Organizations. It is intended for organizations and individuals seeking to comply with the requirements established by the Albanian Civil Aviation Authority (ACAA). The guidance aims to ensure a clear understanding of the applicable procedures, required documentation, and compliance steps throughout the process.

The guidance is intended for national and international continuing airworthiness management organizations that intend to request an approval or acceptance in accordance with Part CAMO, as well as to any other interested stakeholders. The process follows Air Code of Albanian Republic No. 96/2020, DCM No. 1095/2020, transposing Regulation (EU) 1139/2018, Law No. 53/2022 "On organizing and functioning of ACAA" and Minister Order No. 79/2024, which transposes Regulation (EU) 1321/2014, as amended.

2. REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

To initiate the process, the following documents must be submitted to ACAA offices:

- ACAA-DFS-AIM-102: Application Form
- Certificate of Corporate Registration
- Formal Act delegating the Accountable Manager
- ACAA-DFS-AIM-104: Application Form for Nominated Persons (with supporting qualifications and competence documents)
- Continuing Airworthiness Management Exposition (CAME)
- Maintenance Program (*if applicable*)
- Reliability program (*where appropriate*)
- Points of contact of the organization
- Compliance checklist to Part CAMO
- Internal Audit results (*if applicable*)
- Evidence of compliance with CAMO.A.305
- Contract with Albanian operator (*if applicable*)
- The approval certificate (*in case of application for acceptance from ACAA*)
- Any other documents as required by the specific process.

3. STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

3.1 Step 1: Pre-Application

The applicant initiates contact with the ACAA and submits a pre-application package, including the formal request and initial supporting documents. A briefing may be held to clarify the requirements and procedures.

3.2 Application Submission

The applicant submits a complete application package, including all required documents. The ACAA reviews the submission for completeness and compliance with applicable regulations.

3.3 Desktop Audit

The ACAA conducts a desktop audit to evaluate the submitted documentation, including CAME, Maintenance Programs, and qualifications of the nominated postholders. Findings, if any, are communicated for resolution.

3.4 On-Site Audit

An on-site audit is conducted to verify compliance with Part CAMO requirements. The audit team assesses facilities, procedures, and personnel qualifications. If the organization holds an EASA Member State Approval, the on-site audit may be optional based on the internal and CAA audit reports.

It is recommended that the Accountable Manager be present at the first meeting of the initial approval process as well as at the final one.

3.5 Corrective Actions

The organization addresses any findings through a Corrective Action Plan (CAP). The ACAA reviews and verifies the implementation of corrective actions.

3.6 Issuance of Certificate

Upon successful completion of the process, the ACAA issues the approval/acceptance Certificate and associated Approval/Acceptance Schedule. These documents outline the privileges and limitations of the approval.

4. FEES FOR CAMO ORGANIZATION

Based on Joint Instruction No. 11/2024, "For the fees applied by the Albanian Civil Aviation Authority", please find below the fees for the above-mentioned services.

Service	Fee (ALL)	Frequency
For the issuance of a continuing airworthiness management organisation approval certificate and its attachment: when the company employs up to 10 persons.	220,000	Per application
For the issuance of a continuing airworthiness management organisation approval certificate and its attachment: when the company employs more than 10 people.	260,000	Per application
For amendment of the continuing airworthiness management organization approval and its appendix when the scope of activities increases: when the company employs up to 10 people.	90,000	Per application
For amendment of the continuing airworthiness management organization approval and its appendix when the scope of activities increases: when the company employs 10 or more persons.	110,000	Per application
For the change of the continuing airworthiness management organisation approval certificate and its attachment: When the change does not involve an increase in the scope of operations.	20,000	Per application
Authorization of ARC Staff	50,000	Per application
